

A distinctive part number is indicated by a number placed after the letters "AT" and consists of a numeric part followed by alphanumeric characters. A numeric part can also consist of a single or a double letter. In many cases the same letters with different numeric parts can be used. Typically, a numeric part is a part number, and alphanumeric characters are often the name of the product the part belongs to. Matched up with the part number are usually details about a specific board such as a name, series and manufacturing number. While all other components are unique, this number can be used in the same way as serial numbers on a screw or bolt or the chassis on a product. Often a part number contains a company name as well. A typical part number is shown in the following example, which can also be found on a PC motherboard: For example: Is the motherboard code unique to the vendor and board type?.
